Dear Parents and Guardians,

The bell has officially rung, it's holiday time. It has been a very busy, but such an exciting first term. Thank you for your involvement, passion and enthusiasm this term. It takes the commitment of every single member of our family to make St Patrick's CBC the beautiful family tree it is.

The Admin office and ECD Centre will remain open during the school holiday, except for the official public holidays (Friday, 30 March and Monday, 2 April), as well as Friday, 6 April. The entire school will be closed on this day due to urgent infrastructure upgrades.

We have reassessed the **academic achievers'** policy for this year. In the past, we've often found that, due to our school's academic standards, the 4th or 5th place results for many grades were in fact relatively low. For this reason, we've introduced the following criteria for excellence: in order to qualify for a Top 5 badge in Grade 4 – 7, a term average of 80% should be met; for Grades 8 – 9, pupils have to achieve 75% or more to qualify, and the Grade 10 – 12 pupils should obtain at least 70%.

Congratulations to all the pupils who were acknowledged at the **High School Award Assembly** on Monday, as well as to all involved with the **School of the Arts' Quarterly Concert**. You made us very proud.

The **UK tour group** departed from Kimberley early this morning. We pray for safe travels and a blessed trip.

Thank you so much for all the non-perishable items received as part of our school's **Lent Charity Drive**. Literally thousands of items were collected. The collections from the High School were given to Thutong ya Bana and those of the Primary School, to St Vincent de Paul Society. Your generosity enables various community soup kitchens and feeding schemes to function. Please know that your contributions make a difference in the lives of many.
