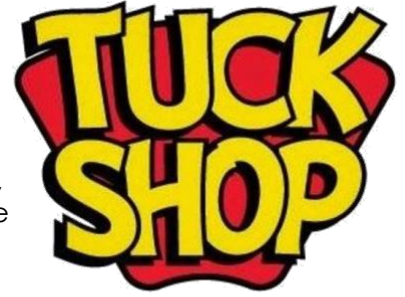
**High School Announcement:** The High School Lollipop Day is taking place on Monday, 2 November 2020.
